Preparing for Amanuwal's Memorial and Days of Unleavened Bread

▶ Take the Physical Preparations Seriously, but with balance.

Yahuwah placed great value on the physical things he required Israel to do. Do not have a careless attitude about the physical things. (Exo 12:14-16, 42; I Cor 5:5-8)

Reconciliation with Yahuwah.

Amanuwal's Memorial is a new beginning. Take care of this before you come participate in his memorial services. (Rom 5:10; 2 Cor 5:18; Eph. 2:16; Col 1:20-21) When we were yet sinners, we were reconciled to Yahuwah by Amanuwal

Reconciliation with Others.

The death of Amanuwal also reconciles men to men. (Eph 2:14-16; Mat 5:23-24) Bury the hatchet – be at peace with everyone.

▶ Self Examination.

Have the right attitude, renew your immersion vows, acknowledge the death of Amanuwal, which makes possible our forgiveness. WE MUST CHANGE! (Cor 11:23-27; 2 Cor 13:5)

Consider What the Footwashing Service means to YOU.

COMMIT YOURSELF TO SERVICE. (John 13) Remember the sins of omission. OUR MOTIVES MUST BE RIGHT.

▶ Meditate on These Subjects in Particular:
