Unmasking the "Day of Yahuwah"

Isaiah 13:6-13

What does the "Day of Yahuwah" refer to? Here is what Scripture tells us about the "Day of Yahuwah."

"... for the day of Yahuwah is at hand; it shall come as a destruction from the Almighty. Therefore shall all hands be faint, and every man's heart shall melt: And they shall be afraid: pangs and sorrows shall take hold of them; they shall be in pain as a woman that travails: they shall be amazed one at another; their faces shall be as flames. Behold, the day of Yahuwah cometh, cruel both with wrath and fierce anger, to lay the land desolate: and he shall destroy the sinners thereof out of it. For the stars of heaven and the constellations thereof shall not give their light: the sun shall be darkened in his going forth, and the moon shall not cause her light to shine. And I will punish the world for their evil, and the wicked for their iniquity."

We see here that the Day of Yahuwah is a day of wrath and vengeance. On this day, Yahuwah's wrath will be poured out and He will destroy the sinner and punish this world for its iniquity. On this day our Father in heaven says that man's hands will be faint and that his heart will melt. This day is compared to the pain of a woman in childbirth. The pains and suffering that Yahuwah will inflict on rebellious mankind will be horrific.

Notice also that on this day that we will see apocalyptic signs in the heavens. Isaiah prophesied that the stars and the sun would be darkened. At our Savior's coming man will be in darkness.

This day will be like the day that Yahuwah smote Egypt with darkness; it'll be darkness so intense that a person will virtually be able to feel its presence.

Joel 2:1-3

"Blow the trumpet in Zion, and sound an alarm in my kadesh mountain: let all the inhabitants of the land tremble: for the day of Yahuwah cometh, for it is nigh at hand; A day of darkness and of gloominess, a day of clouds and of thick darkness, as the morning spread upon the mountains: a great people and a strong; there has not been ever the like, neither shall be any more after it, even to the years of many generations. A fire devours before them; and behind them a flame burns: the land is as the Garden of Eden before them, and behind them a desolate wilderness; yea, and nothing shall escape them."

Many of the same signs that were found in Isaiah are found in Joel. Here Joel or Yah'al meaning Yahuwah is AI, prophesied that the day of Yahuwah would be a day of darkness, a day of Yahuwah's wrath on mankind. All the inhabitants of the land will tremble and quake before Yahuwah. This day will be a day of fear and a day of Yahuwah's indignation. On this day Yahuwah's anger will consume the sinner and those who defy His Word.

There will be no escaping Yahuwah's wrath ON His day of retribution. The small and the great alike will flee, but will find no refuge from Yahuwah's anger.

Zephaniah 1:14-17

"The great day of Yahuwah is near, it is near, and hastens greatly, even the voice of the day of Yahuwah: the mighty man shall cry there bitterly. That day is a day of wrath, a day of trouble and distress, a day of wasteness and desolation, a day of darkness and gloominess, a day of clouds and thick darkness, a day of the trumpet and alarm against the fenced cities, and against the high towers. And I will bring distress upon men that they shall walk like blind men, because they have sinned against Yahuwah."

As we can see, the day of Yahuwah refers to a day when our Father in Heaven will punish this earth for its sins. On this day the mighty men will cry out in fear and trepidation. Zephaniah's prophecy is a dreadful description of what will come to pass on this earth, perhaps not too far into the distant future. Zephaniah describes this day as a day of trouble, a day of desolation, and a day of clouds and of thick darkness. Let us not be deceived about our Savior's coming, we must prepare now for His return.
