You Will Live Again

Second Coming

When I was about three years old, my great-grandmother died. I was devastated. Of course all I knew was that she was gone. Death didn't really register with me. Then at the age of 21 my favorite uncle passed. At this age death registered, yet even then I thought little of my death as I ate healthy and exercised often. I thought death happened to the elderly it still wasn't close to me.

Were they in heaven? Were they up there looking down on me? Did they go to hell? It hurts to lose love ones. Yahuwah knows that. And He reveals death as an enemy – the last enemy that shall be destroyed (I Corinthians 15:26).

At Mashyach's second coming, at the 7th trump, the saints will rise from the dead to meet Him in the air, caught up together with him in the clouds (I Thessalonians 4:16-17).

The Feast of Trumpets, the fourth annual festival Yahuwah gave his people (Leviticus 23:23-25), pictures the beginning of these events. Amanuwal and his saints will descend to the Mount of Olives near Jerusalem (Zechariah 14:4). From there Mashyach and the saints will institute the government of Yahuwah around the world.

But what about the rest of the dead? What about my great grandmother and uncle? What about your loved ones? Yahuwah's plan includes hope for them, too.

Overview of Resurrections

The resurrection of the dead takes place at three different times. Let's note them here:

The first resurrection is for the dead in Ha'Mashyach, the first-fruits, who will become immortal beings (Revelation 20:6).

These were called and chosen. They obeyed Yahuwah and his commandments. They suffered privation and persecution. They remained faithful to Ha'Mashyach's good news to their deaths (Matthew 24:13, Revelation 6:9-11).

They will live again! When they are resurrected at Amanuwal Ha'Mashyach's return, they will be raised with a body of spirit, not flesh (I Corinthians 15:42-44, 49-54). They, with the saints who are alive when He returns, will be given eternal life.

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The second resurrection is for those who died without understanding the good news. They will live again AFTER the 1,000 years are finished (Revelation 20:5, first part). They will be resurrected to physical bodies. This will give them their first and only chance to understand and obey Mashyach's good news (Ezekiel 37:1-14, Revelation 20:11-12).

The third resurrection is for those who knew the truth of the good news but deliberately turned their backs on it. They became incorrigible, unwilling to repent, committing the unpardonable sin. They will be raised to a physical existence to be burned up (Revelation 20:13-15, Hebrews 6:4-8).

My great grandmother and uncle will live again. I will again be able to see them, serve them and love them. But to see them, I must be changed at the first resurrection. Yahuwah's judgment is now on me and on all who are of The Way – who are a part of the spiritual body of Amanuwal (I Peter 4:17).

Will you Hear The Trumpet?

"Cry aloud, spare not; lift up your voice like a trumpet; tell My people their transgressions, and the house of Jacob their sins" (Isaiah 58:1).

Yahuwah's called out ones, through the scriptures, social media, etc. are being warned to prepare for the spiritual battles ahead (II Corinthians 10:3-6).

If you respond to this small warning, you are likely to hear the 7 trumpets of Yahuwah and be changed to a spirit begin at the first resurrection!

The Feast of Trumpets heralds the return of Amanuwal Ha'Mashyach and the first resurrection. This day begins his plan of resurrection from the dead.

You can be among the first-fruits who will be changed into eternal, spirit essence. You can be a younger brother or sister of Amanuwal Ha'Mashyach (I John 3:1-3, Romans 8:29).
